Dr Cunningham helped set up one of the first One Stop Breast Clinics and has provided the imaging for these busy clinics ever since. Dr Cunningham is now the Lead Clinician for breast services at Imperial College Healthcare, which includes all of the breast service both symptomatic and screening.

Operational/technical workflow

4ways uses the N3 network to securely transfer images from the system of the originating department to the 4ways system and to our dedicated mammography and breast MRI radiologists.

All clinical details and, if necessary, previous imaging will be facilitated by our dedicated operations team to ensure radiologists can provide a fully integrated reporting service and compliance with RCR reporting guidelines. All data is kept within UK boundaries and in accordance with information governance guidelines.

Audit

If you decide to use 4ways to report your studies for you, then we will anonymously audit 10% of the studies we have done as part of our service agreement, as a matter of course.

We can also provide a service whereby we audit your radiology reports for you.
